Grants

Grants awarded by The Community Foundation (TCF) continue to support its focus, *Strengthening Families—Strengthening Communities*, and generally fall within one of five strategic focus areas. Under each heading, you will see a description of the issue areas addressed by these strategies. TCF, together with its supporting organizations and regional affiliates awarded grants totaling \$33 million in 2010.

Within each strategy, you will see that the list is further organized by type of grant. **Community grants** are those that enable the Foundation to exercise its discretion through an intensive review process conducted by our program staff and a committee of the board. **Donor advised and designated grants** are those in which individual donors who have established funds recommend support to specific organizations at any time throughout the year.

TCF program staff evaluates all recommendations to determine that grants will be used exclusively for public charitable purposes and conducts a due diligence review of all organizations.
