A Grace Place Adult Care Center **\$25,000**

To support the Nutrition and Wellness Program, which will provide meals and snacks that meet the dietary needs of the adults in the program. A Grace Place provides daytime care services for adults with disabilities and chronic age-related health conditions.

American Cancer Society/South Atlantic Division **\$25,000**

To support the African American Men's Health Initiative, which addresses the issue of higher cancer incidence and other catastrophic diseases.

Capital Area Health Network **\$50,000**

To support a partnership with the Richmond City Health District to increase access to family planning services for uninsured women by providing clinical services in the communities where high-risk populations live.

CARITAS **\$50,000**

To provide cooperative substance abuse counseling services for clients of CARITAS, Offender Aid and Restoration, Freedom House, the Salvation Army, YWCA and Hilliard House.

ChildSavers **\$65,000**

To support the Trauma Response program for the 2010/2011 program year.

Cross Over Ministry **\$55,000**

To provide salary support for a full-time Volunteer Manager.

Family Lifeline **\$50,000**

To support the Healthy Families program, which serves at-risk families living in Richmond's Northside and Church Hill communities and Henrico County.

Gateway Homes of Greater Richmond Inc. **\$60,000**

To provide support for the Community Healthcare Specialist and the Community Support and Affordable Housing Programs.

Greater Richmond SCAN **\$50,000**

To provide education, support, and treatment services through the Family Support Program, Child Advocacy Center, and FAM Prevention Program.

Hanover Safe Place **\$25,000**
To provide salary support for a Community Case Manager to support individuals and families requesting services due to domestic violence and/or sexual assault.

Instructive Visiting Nurse Association (IVNA) **\$66,000**
To support the Charity Care Services program, which provides a variety of home care and wellness services to under or uninsured persons in Central Virginia.

McShin Foundation **\$25,000**
To provide operating support for the organization's residential housing programs for individuals and families in recovery from substance abuse addictions.

Rx Partnership **\$15,000**
To support the delivery of bulk medications to the Community Pharmacy at Cross Over Ministry and the Richmond area organizations that it serves.

Safe Harbor **\$20,000**
To support the hotline, shelter and community counseling programs for women suffering from domestic violence.

Virginia Institute of Pastoral Care **\$24,000**
